Officers work independently performing law enforcement and crime prevention work including discovery, investigation, report preparation and patrol to enforce federal, state and local laws.

Candidates for the Police Officer position must have a current Oregon Public Safety Academy/DPSST certification at time of application, possess a valid driver's license with a good driving record, and must not have been convicted of any crime or violation classifiable as a Class A misdemeanor or higher. Candidates must also possess the equivalent to high school diploma, supplemented with college-level coursework in administration of justice, be capable of swearing the oath of office and eligible to legally work in the United States.

All North Plains Officers work on shifts independently, patrolling the City and interacting with Washington County Consolidated Communications (WCCA) and other law enforcement agencies.

As part of the screening process candidates are subject to a rigorous interview process, background check, drug test and psychological examination.
